If you knit, weave, spin, sew, braid or hook rugs, felt, crochet, or quilt with wool or other natural animal fibers, you can join the celebration of Maine's vibrant fiber industry by participating in the Make It With Fiber In Maine competition. The contest is open to participants of all ages and all levels of experience.

Competition Rules:

- All items must be made of at least 75% natural animal fiber.
- All items must have been made since July 1 of the previous year.
- Items may be made from original design or commercial pattern, and may be of handspun or commercially processed fibers.
- Any type of construction will be considered; knit, sewn, felted, woven, etc.
- Do NOT include your name or any identifying information on your item.
- Complete a separate entry form for each item.
- All items, with entry forms, must be brought to the Office/Kitchen for registration between 8:30 and 10:00 a.m. on Saturday. Judging will begin immediately after 10:00.
- Please remove all wrappings, bags, etc. from your item.
- All items must be left on display until 3:00 p.m. on Sunday and picked up no later than 4:00 p.m. Arrangements for pick-up or mailed return must be made at time of entry. Please bring a pre-paid mailer box to return your item.
